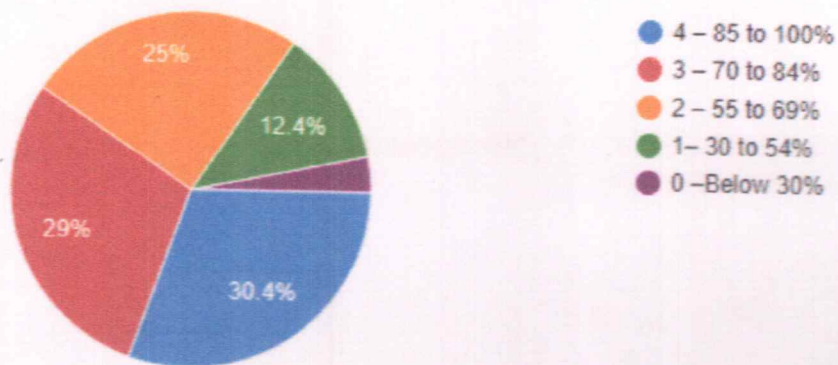

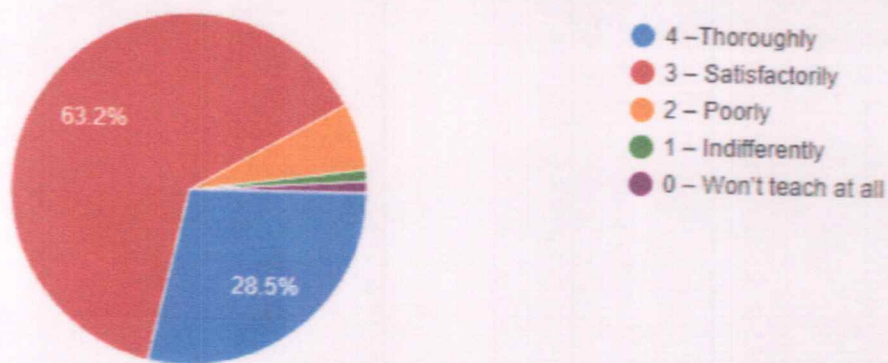
Student Satisfaction Survey for A.Y. 2020-21

The Student Satisfaction Survey was taken as per the guidelines given by NAAC. Following are the statistics of the survey.

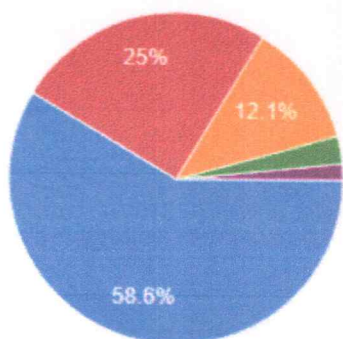
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? (372 responses)



2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? (372 responses)

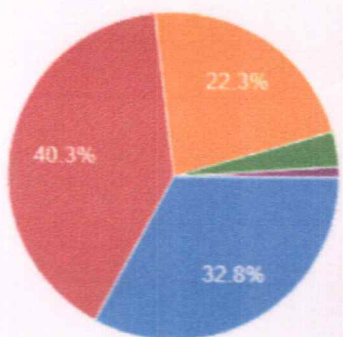


3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? (372 responses)



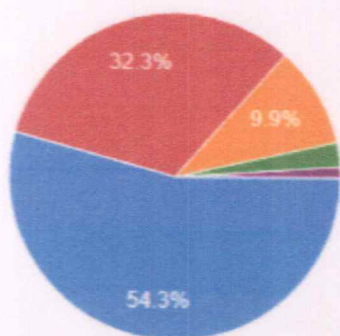

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as (372 responses)



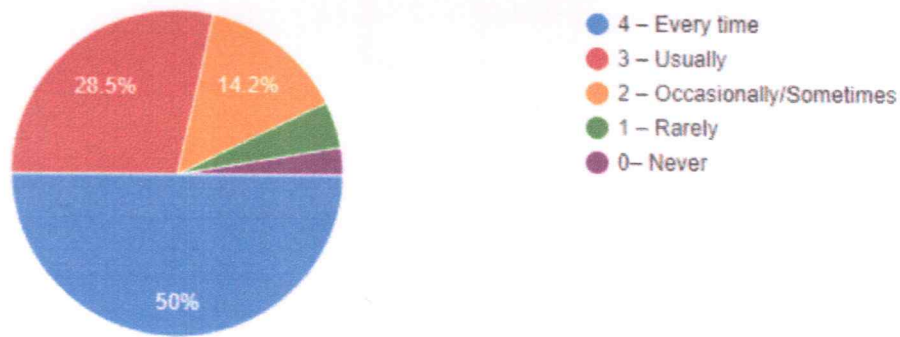

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. (372 responses)

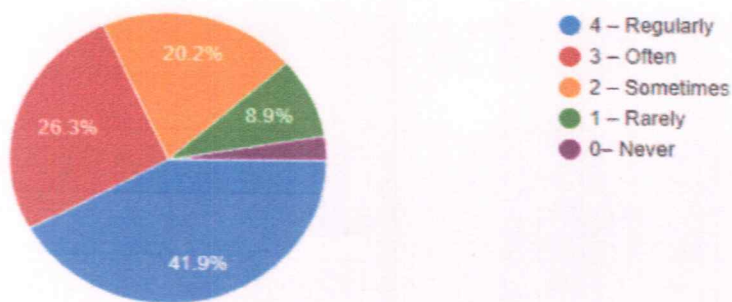

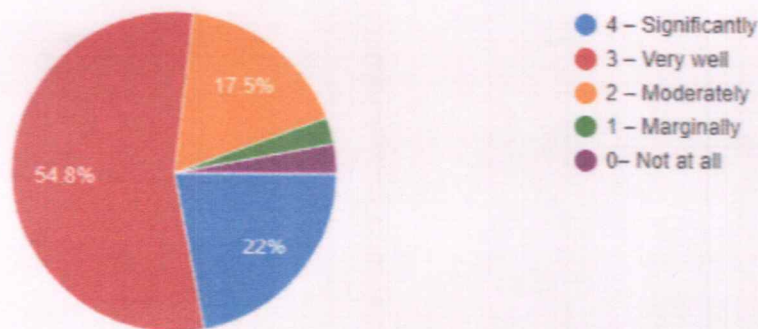
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? (372 responses)



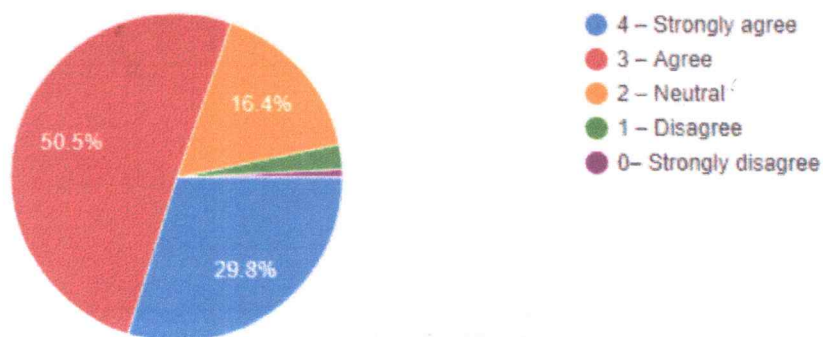
7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students (372 responses)



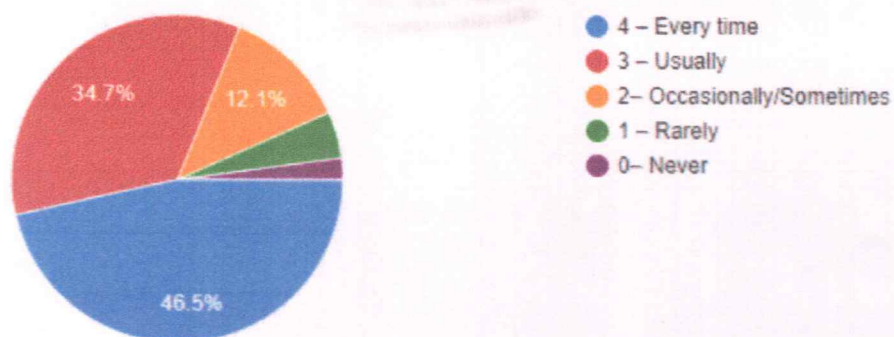
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth (372 responses)



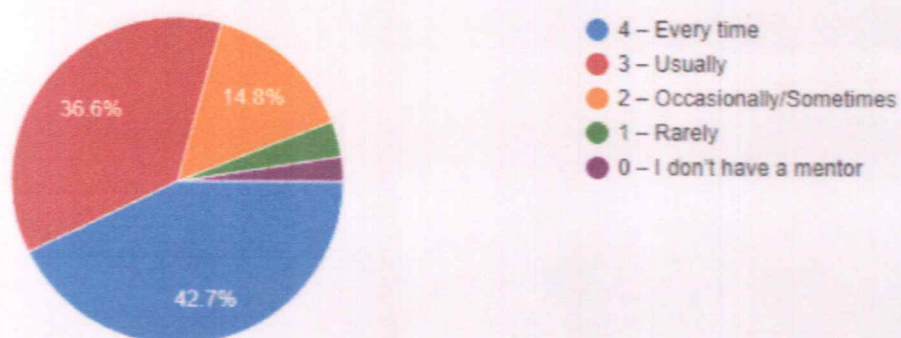
9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. (372 responses)



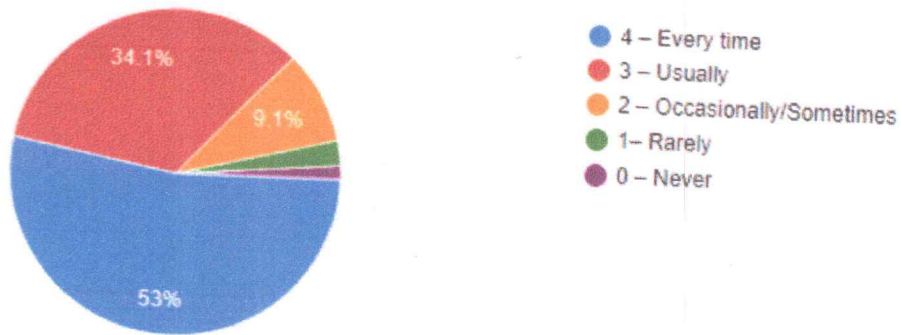
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes. (372 responses)



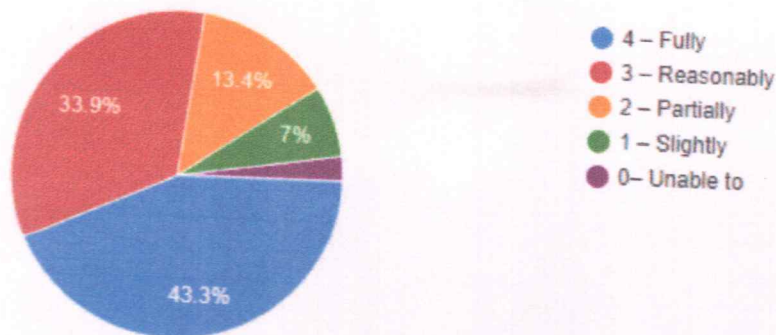
11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. (372 responses)



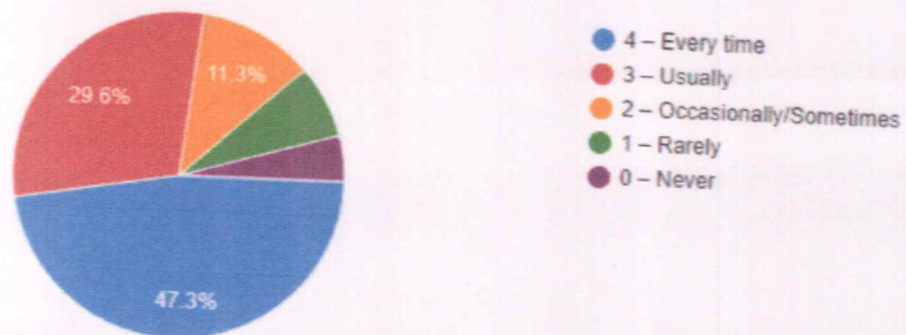
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. (372 responses)



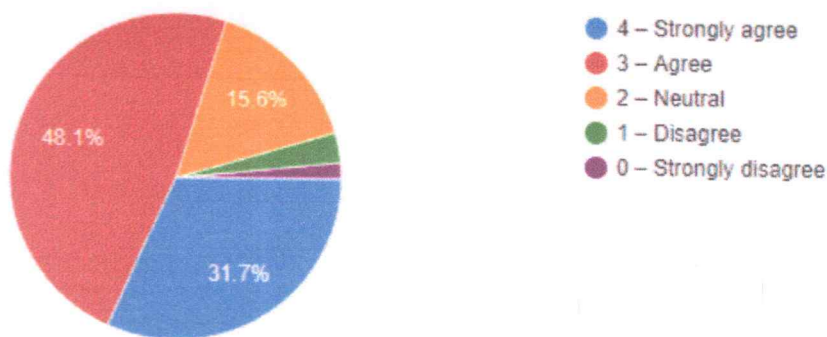
13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges (372 responses)



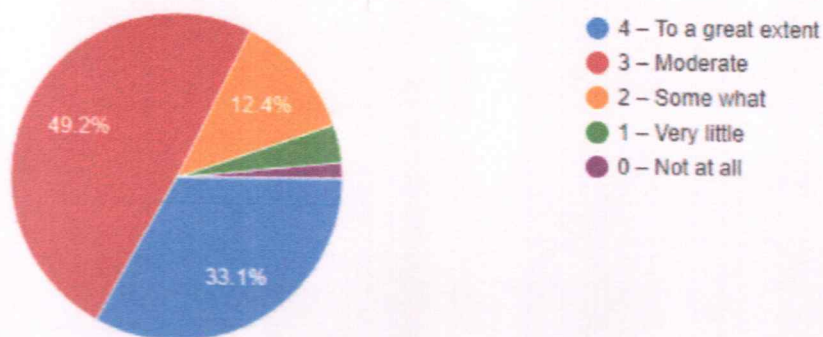
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. (372 responses)



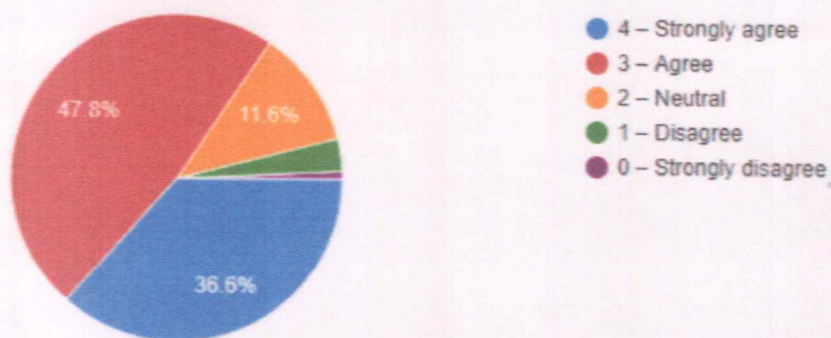
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. (372 responses)



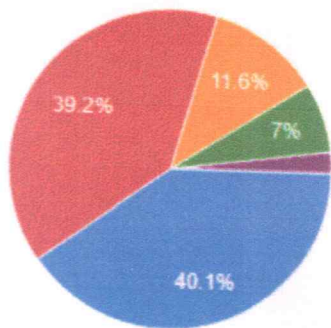
16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. (372 responses)



17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities (372 responses)

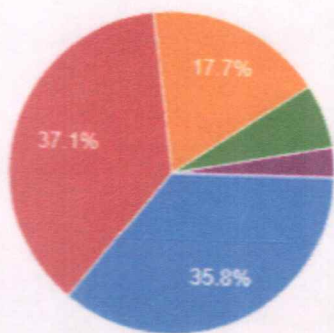


18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work. (372 responses)



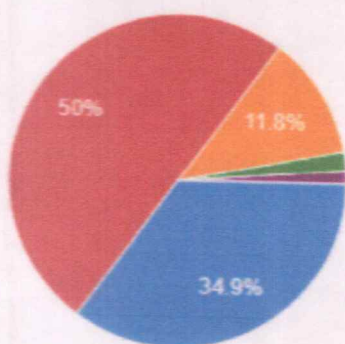

19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching (372 responses)





