A.Y. 2022-23

A) Student

1. 48% student said very good for the adequacy of the course content in relation to the expected Course Outcomes,40% student said excellent and 12% student said good.
2. 48% student opined that the syllabus is career oriented ,39% student said very good,13% students said good.
3. 45% student said excellent with respect to the electives/specialization offered and that they are relevant to the industry needs, 39% said very good and 16% said good.
4. 43% student reported excellent to the internal evaluation scheme designed for each of the course ,41% said very good and 16% said good.
5. 43% student reported excellent and very good that the syllabus enabled them to improve their ability to formulate, analyze and solve problems and 14% said good.
6. 43% student said excellent for the course/syllabus and that it had good balance between theory and application, 45% student said very good and 12% said good.
7. 48% student rated excellent for the course/syllabus and that the subject increased their knowledge and perspective in the subject area, 39% student said very good and 13% said good.



B) Alumni

1. 34% alumni's said excellent to the relevance of syllabus with respect to profession, 33% said very good and 33% said good.
2. 33% alumni's said excellent for their overall learning experience at KCES's IMR, Jalgaon, 34% said very good and 33% said good.
3. 33% alumni's reported excellent to Infrastructure (Computer Lab, library etc.), 33% reported very good and 33% reported good.
4. 30% alumni's said excellent regarding the Sports facilities provided by the Institute, 28% said very good and 42% said good.
5. 33% alumni's opined excellent for Training & Placement (T & P) assistance, 33% opined very good and 34% opined good.
6. 34% alumni's said excellent regarding Career counseling and guidance for higher studies, 34% said very good and 32% said good.
7. 67% alumni's said excellent regarding the teacher-student relationship, 25% said very good and 8% said good.
8. 26% alumni's said excellent for Alumni Association/Network, 33% said very good and 41% said good.
9. 47% alumni's reported excellent for Curricular, Co-Curricular and Extra-curricular activities, 33% said very good and 20% said good.
10. 33% alumni's reported excellent regarding overall rating of the Institute, 33% said very good and 34% said good.



C) Parents

1. 42% parents said excellent for infrastructure facilities, 26% said very good and 32% said good.
2. 48% parents opined excellent regarding quality & relevance of the syllabus, 24% opined very good and 28% opined good.
3. 47% parents reported excellent outcomes achieved from the program while 23% reported very good and 30% reported good outcomes.
4. 66% parents reported excellent transparency with respect to the evaluation system in the institute, 32% reported very good and 8% good.
5. 64% parents reported excellent teaching-learning environment, 21% reported very good and 15% good.
6. 26% parents said excellent learning resources such as Library, Internet, Computer etc., 42% reported very good and 32% good.
7. 36% parents reported that excellent encouragement is provided to students for participation in Co-curricular and Extracurricular activities, 43% reported very good and 21% good.
8. 35% parents reported excellent institutional sensitivity to changing educational, social & market demands, 19% reported very good and 46% good.
9. 34% parents reported excellent value based education, 34% reported very good and 32% good.
10. 44% parents rated excellent discipline practices, 33% said very good and 33% said good.



D) Employers

1. 40% of the employers rated excellent relevance of the courses in relation to the program, 50% rated good and 10% rated fair.
2. 10% of the employers rated excellent sufficiency of the courses related to industry, 90% rated good.
3. 40% of the employers rated excellent to the competencies in relation to the course content, 50% rated good and 10% rated fair.
4. 20% of the employers rated excellent to the sequence of the units in the syllabus, 70% rated good and 10% rated fair.
5. 40% of the employers rated excellent regarding the topics to the Industry, 40% rated good and 20% rated fair.
6. 20% of the employers rated excellent to the offering of the specialization streams, 50% rated good and 30% rated fair.
7. 10% of the employers rated excellent regarding offering of the electives in relation to the Technological advancements, 40% rated good and 50% rated fair.
8. 10% of the employers rated excellent to the skills suitable to the Industry, 50% rated good and 40% rated fair.
9. 30% of the employers rated excellent regarding applicability of the domains and the tools used for designing the experiments in terms of existing practices in the Industry, 50% rated good and 20% rated fair.
