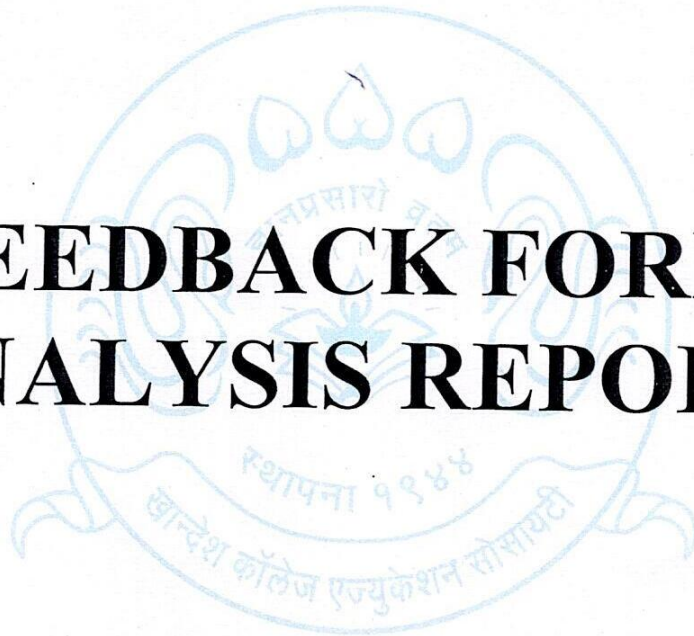


FEEDBACK FORM ANALYSIS REPORT

A) Students:

Total number of samples - 05

- ✓ 40% students are strongly agree that the course contents was satisfactory and 40% are agreed whereas 20% said neutral.
- ✓ 40% respondents is strongly agreeing that the prescribed curriculum is useful, 40% students found that they are agree and 20% are neutral.
- ✓ 40% students is strongly agreeing that the prescribed reading of the syllabi is easily available, 40% are neutral whereas 20% found agree.
- ✓ 60% respondents agreed that the depth of the course contents is satisfactory 20% strongly agree whereas 20% not agree with the view.
- ✓ 60% students strongly agreed that the course objectives were clearly presented and met 20% agreed, whereas 20% not agree with the view.
- ✓ 80% respondents agreed that the syllabi help in imbibing socio cultural values and 20% is neutral with the view.
- ✓ 40% students is strongly agree that the syllabus fostered global competencies among students, 40% said neural and 20% students are agreed with the view.
- ✓ 40% respondents strongly agree that the syllabus is technology friendly and enables teachers and students to use technology. 40% students are agreeing and 20% said not agree.
- ✓ 40% students strongly agreed whereas 40% agreed that the curriculum is apt in terms of learning values, skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities and broadening perspectives and 20% are said neutral.



B) Alumni:

Total number of samples – 05

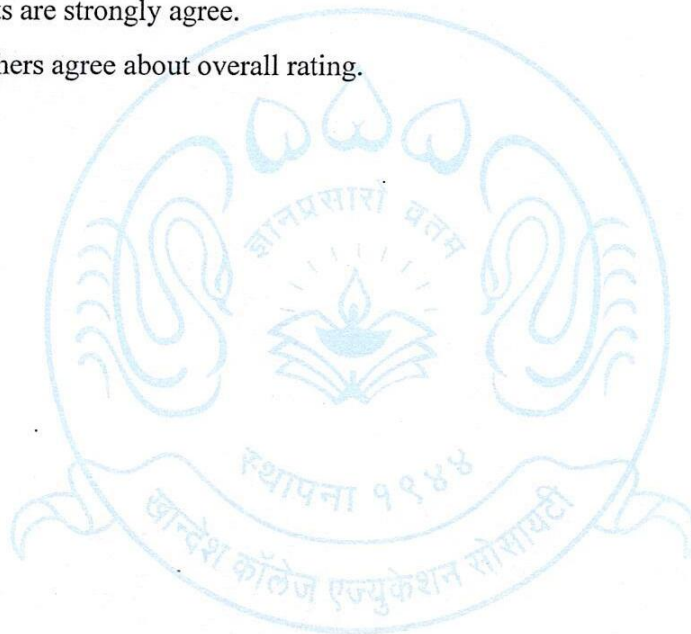
- ✓ 80% respondents said about the syllabus was adequate, whereas 20% said it is challenging.
- ✓ 80% alumni stated that amount of syllabus they think was covered during prescribed lecture hours 75-90%. 20% stated 50-75%.
- ✓ 60% respondents said yes, the time at IMR been intellectually enriching, 20% said marginally, whereas 20% said no.
- ✓ 60% respondents agreed that the curriculum designed by the University is useful for their Profession /Business, and 20% strongly agree whereas 20% are neutral.
- ✓ 60% respondents agreed that the curriculum designed really produced skills, talents and acumen required for their Business /Profession, and 20% strongly agree, whereas 20% said neutral.
- ✓ 40% alumni strongly agreed that the subjects studied are in line with today's requirement in the industry, 40% said neutral whereas 20% said it is agree.
- ✓ 80% respondents agreed that the syllabus helped in reflecting Socio-Cultural values in them and is really coordinating with their respective work culture, whereas 20% is not agree about the view.
- ✓ 60% alumni said agree that when they compare their self with other counterparts from other colleges/university, they feel that they got some extra which is not available in other institutes 20% strongly agree whereas 20% said neutral.
- ✓ 40% respondents are neutral that when they meet students who have taken a similar program at other universities they feel that their program is superior, 20% are strongly agreed, 20% agree whereas 20% said strongly not agree.



C) Teacher:

Total number of samples – 05

- ✓ 60% teachers agree that the syllabus is defined in a way to clarify your teaching goals and expectations of students whereas 40% teachers are strongly agree.
- ✓ 60% respondents rating agree that the syllabus bridges the gap between industry standards/current global scenarios and academics and 40% are strongly agree with it.
- ✓ 80% teachers agreed the ease of timely coverage of syllabus is achieved in the mentioned number of hours, whereas 20% are strongly agree.
- ✓ 100% respondents agreed that the number of reference material and books available for the topics are mentioned in the syllabus.
- ✓ 80% teachers agreed that the syllabus is in line with learning value (in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities or broadening perspectives) and 20% respondents are strongly agree.
- ✓ 100% teachers agree about overall rating.



D) Parents:

Total number of samples – 05

- ✓ 60% parents said good about vision and mission statement of the institute 40% said excellent.
- ✓ 60% respondents said very good infrastructure facilities and 20% said good whereas 20% said average.
- ✓ 60% respondents said good effectiveness of NMU syllabus, and 40% said excellent.
- ✓ 60% respondents stated very good teaching-learning environment whereas 20% said good, 20% said excellent.
- ✓ 60% parents was rating very good teaching methodology and techniques 20% said excellent whereas 20% rate good.
- ✓ 60% respondents stated good learning resources such as library, internet, and 40% said excellent.
- ✓ 40% parents found very good system of monitoring student's progress, whereas 20% said excellent, 20% rate good and 20% said average.
- ✓ 60% respondent's stated very good encouragement provided to students for participation in academic forums whereas 40% said excellent.
- ✓ 60% parents was rating good competence & commitment of faculty whereas 40% rate very good.
